





First Floor Plan







Review and critique of House on a Hill


Residential design was something I knew I wanted to explore in greater detail throughout my studies. I naively believed this would become a focus in my work instead of understanding it as a component of the built environment. The House on a Hill project was the earliest investigation into residential design, but the strict nature of the assignment focused on formal compositional programming of a house rather than treating it as a study in dwelling design. There was an opportunity to study transparency in a private dwelling through the facade study and design. This would become a theme throughout multiple academic studies, particularly the 384 W project during my graduate studies, and continue in my current personal and collaborative endeavors.
